GENERAL ELECTION

The Municipal Election Commission of the City of Walterboro announces the General Election for the City of Walterboro to be **Tuesday, November 3, 2015.**

The following offices shall be included in this election:
3 City Council Members

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above listed offices may file at Walterboro City Hall, 242 Hampton Street, Walterboro, SC 29488 and pay the appropriate filing fee of \$254.60 for the office of Council Member. **Books will be open for filing beginning August 26, 2015 at 8:00 A.M. and remain open during regular business hours until 5:00 P.M. on September 4, 2015.**

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

Any person wishing to register to vote in this election must do so no later than October 3, 2015. To register, one must contact the Colleton County Voters Registration Office, located at 115-A Benson St., Walterboro, SC. Persons who are registered and who live inside the city limits of Walterboro are eligible to vote in this election. If the number 215 appears under municipality on your voters' registration card, you are an eligible voter in municipal elections.

Voters will be asked to provide one of the following Photo ID's: S.C. Driver's License, ID Card Issued by S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles, S.C. Voter Registration Card with Photo, Federal Military ID or U.S. Passport. For more information on Photo ID, visit scVOTES.org or contact the Colleton County Voters Registration Office at 549-2842.

The following polling locations will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day:
Walterboro # 1 and Peniel - Old Forest Circle Middle School (right side of school in classroom); 500 Forest Circle
Walterboro # 2 – Hampton Street Colleton Center (Carn Street Entrance); 494 Hampton Street
Walterboro # 3 - Clemson Cooperative Extension Building; 611 Black St. (new location)
Walterboro # 4 and # 5 – Old Forest Circle Middle School (left side of school in cafeteria); 500 Forest Circle
Walterboro # 6 - Colleton County Fire & Rescue Station #24; 111 Foxfield Rd. (new polling precinct and location)

At 9:00 a.m. on Election Day, the Municipal Election Commission will begin examining the absentee ballot return envelopes. This examination will be held at the Colleton County Voters Registration Office, 115-A Benson Street, Walterboro, SC.

On Thursday, November 5, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. at the Colleton County Voters Registration Office, the Municipal Election Commission will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.

Any run-off will be held two weeks after the election on Tuesday, November 17, 2015.

The City operates under the Nonpartisan Election and Runoff Election Method as specified by South Carolina Code, 1976, as amended, Section 5-15-62.
