Residents and business owners of Colleton County, South Carolina and Incorporated Areas are invited to attend an open house to learn how and why the local risk of flooding has changed, how the proposed new flood maps will be used, and steps they can take to protect themselves from the extensive damage that floods often cause.

At the open house, community officials, FEMA Representatives, the Engineering Study Contractor and insurance representatives will be on hand to answer questions about flood risk changes and review the proposed new flood maps. They will also help residents and businesses determine if their property may be subject to any related insurance requirements and explain how property owners affected by the change may be able to reduce future insurance costs. The format of the Public Outreach Open House is very informal. No presentations are made and there are no formal questions or statements from the public.
