Sealed Bids for the construction of the **2025 Water Supply Improvements** will be received by the **City of Walterboro in Council Chambers at the Walterboro City Hall** located at **242 Hampton Street, Walterboro, SC 29488** until **Thursday, September 29, 2026, at 2:00 p.m.** local time. At that time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

The Project consists of construction of a new 400 GPM Thunderbolt Drive Well, a wellhouse, chlorination system, associated piping, sitework, 100 kW emergency generator, and all related appurtenances. It will also include renovation of the existing Well No. 4AB Stevens to increase its production from 1,100 GPM to 1,300 GPM, chlorination system, associated piping, a new 300 kW emergency generator, and related items.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: **2025 Water Supply Improvements and related work.**

If awarded, the contract will be on a unit price basis with alternates. No bid may be withdrawn for 90 days after the time has been called on the date of opening. The Owner reserves the right to waive any irregularities, or to reject any or all bids. A bid bond must accompany bids in an amount not less than 5% of the base bid. A performance bond and a payment bond will be required in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price.

The Owner will award the project to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the unit price bid with alternates per City of Walterboro's procurement rules and regulations. Please mark the Project Name and "Bid Enclosed" on the outside of the envelope.

This project is being funded in whole or in part by the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). All federal CDBG requirements will apply to the contract. All contractors and subcontractors are required to be registered in the federal System for Award Management (SAM). Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 & Order No. 11375 which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and 40 CFR 33.240.

Bidders must also make positive efforts to use small and minority-owned business and to offer employment, training and contracting opportunities in accordance with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968. Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.
