

## Walterboro Police Department

### Annual Report for 2015

The information regarding criminal activity in the City of Walterboro is derived from Police Central, a computer program that stores and reports crime. Other information is made available by CAD, a computer assisted dispatch program that records information including dates, times and who responds to the calls for service. This information is divided into two groups, violent crimes and property crimes.

#### **Violent Crimes**

Overall, violent crimes in the city of Walterboro were reduced from 54 in 2014 to 50 in 2015. This is a 7% reduction.

In 2014 the city reported one murder. There were none in 2015.

There were 4 rapes reported in 2014 and 2015. Of the four in 2015, 1 actually occurred in 2014 and wasn't reported until 2015 and 2 were found to be untrue. The actual number should be 1.

There were 18 robberies in 2015 and 13 in 2014, up 38%. Of those 3 were known to be fabricated to cover illegal activities.

There were 28 aggravated assaults reported in 2015, down from 36 in 2014. This reflects a 22% reduction.

#### **Property Crimes**

Overall, property crimes decreased from 625 to 442 in 2015. This is a 29% reduction.

Burglaries decreased by 18 in 2015. 67 were reported in 2014 and 49 in 2015, a decrease of 27%.

Larceny decreased from 540 last year to 375 in 2015. This reflects a 31% decrease and a 5 year low.

Motor vehicle theft increased by 15% from thirteen in 2014 to 15 in 2015, an increase of two.

Arson cases decreased from five in 2014 to three in 2015.

## **Calls for Service**

There was an increase of calls for service by 1%. They increased from 11,961 in 2014 to 12,083 for 2015.

Traffic accidents increased from 655 in 2014 to 692 in 2015. This reflects 37 more accidents or a 6% increase.

Arrests increased from 846 in 2014 to 948 in 2015. This is 102 more arrests, or 12 %. Police Central shows that in 2014, there were 839 cases cleared by arrest and in 2015 there were 951. This reflects an increase of 13%.
